**Criteria :**

- A willingness to “partner” with Topeka Habitat for Humanity with 300 hours of “sweat equity” on your home or in other parts of the habitat program.
- Have a need for a house the size Habitat is able to build, a need for decent and affordable housing.
- Employed for at least 1 year.
- No SRS Liens.
- No bankruptcies in the last year.
- Credit checks are done to show pattern of paying regularly on bills.
- Ability to make monthly house payment, support the cost of homeownership (repairs and upkeep) along with other indebtedness (car, furniture payments, student loans, etc.)
- Background check to insure good neighbor.

Homeowners are selected according to criteria that do not discriminate on the basis of race, creed or ethnic. Final selection of families are who is most in need of decent housing, interested in being good citizens of their neighborhood and meet the criteria.

Topeka Habitat for Humanity is a people-to-people partnership drawing families and communities in need together with volunteers and resources to build decent and affordable housing. Habitat is committed to the development and uplifting of families and communities, not only to building houses.
